The Town of Huntsville, is one of six municipalities in Muskoka. This includes Bracebridge, Gravenhurst, Townships of Georgian Bay, Lake of Bays, Muskoka Lakes, The Wahta Mohawk Territory and Moose Point 79. We are visited by 2.1 millions people per year. There are 100,000 seasonal residents, 50,000 permanent residents many from the film, arts and cultural arenas. We have been known as a 'Summer Colony'. But demographics indicate that is changing with more people living and working here year round. Film North will extend the season through September by offering a venue to participate in world class cinema away from large urban stresses. Adjacent to Algonquin Park's 7,630 square kilometres of lakeland forest, Huntsville's 700.9 square kilometres will continue to attract visitors to this northern oasis of paradise.
